

GETTING A COURT ORDER FOR NAME CHANGE BROWN COUNTY

What to File:

- You will need:
- 1) Completed Application for Change of Name
(Adults: Forms 21.0, 21.1, 21.5)
(Minors: Forms 21.2, 21.3, 21.4, 21.5)
 - 2) Certified copy of birth certificate; and
 - 3) \$126.00 filing fee.

Note: An applicant for change of name must have lived in Brown County for at least one continuous year at the time of the application. The applicant need not present proof of residency. However, the applicant must sign the Application for Change of Name, which includes a statement that the applicant has lived in the county for at least one year immediately prior to filing the application.

Note: The Brown County Probate Court does not grant fee waivers for name changes. Equitas Health and TransOhio are currently working to secure financial assistance for those who need help with fees.

Where to File:

File in person at the Brown County Probate Court, located at 510 E. State St., Suite 1, Georgetown, OH 45121, (937) 378-6549.

Fees:

\$126.00 filing fee by cash or money order made payable to Seneca County Probate Court. You may not pay with personal checks or credit/debit cards.

Tips for Filing:

- Use your full middle name instead of your middle initial.
- Your application **must be typed**.

Publication:

Notice of your name change application must be published one time **at least 30 days before** your hearing in the Brown County Press. The probate court will provide for the required publication of your application for change of name, and this service is included in the \$126.00 filing fee.
